The Avenue Scholars program provides an array of resources to help Scholars persist to career entry. Each Scholar is assigned a Career Coach at both the high school (High School Career Coach) and career levels (Career Services Coach) of the program to guide their personal and career-related development during their junior and senior years of high school, during training, and into career entry. Additionally, the Avenue Scholars Business Outreach Team engages area businesses to provide career awareness, exploration, and employment opportunities, while the Avenue Scholars Community Resource staff collaborates with school district professionals to provide referrals to community resources addressing life and social/emotional needs.

Program Guarantees

Education/Training

A committed Avenue Scholars participant graduates from high school, completes relevant career education or training, and is goal-oriented toward an Avenue Scholars approved pathway.

Work Experience

A committed Avenue Scholars participant demonstrates a successful work history.

Work-Ready Skills

A committed Avenue Scholars participant demonstrates work-ready habits and skills including responsibility, work ethic, communication, positive attitude, professionalism, teamwork, and problem solving.

Attendance

A committed Avenue Scholars participant demonstrates consistent attendance at school, work, and Avenue Scholars engagements.

Financial and Personal Well-Being


A committed Avenue Scholars participant demonstrates the ability to:


- Overcome barriers of all types including financial, physical, and mental, which may affect employment.
- Access community resources and services when necessary.




High School Graduation Rate

Participants by Race



Program Model

PHASE 1 HIGH SCHOOL

Eligible Students: Students are selected for the program during their sophomore year based on:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Interest in pursuing a career in an Avenue Scholars high-demand field requiring an associate degree or less
- 3. Attendance at an Avenue Scholars partner high school

Career Coaching & Education:

At Avenue Scholars, we refer to our students as "Scholars" not just for their academic pursuits but to honor their resilience and determination. Each Scholar takes a for-credit class in their high school taught by an Avenue Scholars High School Career Coach. Their coach guides them in their personal and career-related development through curriculum delivery and wrap-around intrusive support.

PHASE 2 CAREER TRAINING

Education & Training: Avenue

PHASE 3 CAREER ENTRY

After completing their education and training, Scholars work with Avenue Scholars Career Services Coaches to obtain a high-demand, financially sustaining career that requires an associate degree or less.

For Scholars to successfully complete the Avenue Scholars program and be eligible for Alumni status, they are coached toward obtaining a career that meets the following criteria:

- Full-time employment
- A living wage
- Employer-provided health insurance and retirement benefits
- Working in a field aligned with Avenue Scholars' supported industries
- Opportunities for upward mobility

ALUMNI

Avenue Scholars Career Services Coaches support Scholars for up to six months following entry into a financially sustaining career. They are then invited to stay connected to Avenue Scholars as a Program Alum, and are encouraged to engage in events and activities to support and motivate Scholars working in Phases 1 and 2.

Ongoing Support

Scholars Receive Ongoing Support From Junior Year to Alumni Status

- The Avenue Scholars Business Outreach Team collaborates closely with Avenue Scholars' business partners to co-create impactful career-building experiences. These include career awareness and exploration events, mock interviews, job shadowing opportunities, internships, and referrals to both full- and parttime employment. This partnership not only enhances the quality of these initiatives but also ensures that Scholars receive real-world insights and access to valuable resources, setting them on a path to professional success.
- All Career Coaches work with Omaha area. education and business partners to help Scholars navigate their education and training needs.
- The Avenue Scholars Community Resource Team collaborates with student support services within Avenue Scholars partner schools and community organizations to provide wraparound support, addressing challenges that may impact a student's high school graduation and career progression.



Avenue Scholars is dedicated to helping Omaha-area youth overcome educational barriers by offering personalized, continuous support that begins in their junior year of high school. This support not only guides Scholars toward graduation but also helps them explore financially sustaining, high-demand careers. The assistance extends through career training and the first six months of their career.

Eligibility for the program is based on financial need, determined by qualifying for free or reduced-price school lunch or a Federal Pell Grant. Scholars must also demonstrate an interest in pursuing a high-demand career field and attend an Avenue Scholars partner high school.

CAREER AWARENESS/ EXPLORATION

Boot camps and Career Awareness experiences provide Scholars with invaluable opportunities to explore and learn about their desired career paths, develop essential skills, and connect with professionals in their fields of interest.

REFERRALS

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

INTERNSHIPS

Offer meaningful internship opportunities that allow Scholars to gain valuable work experience within specific industry areas. Internships include dedicated mentorship, skill-building opportunities, and competitive pay. We facilitate internships at the high school level offering work-based learning experiences to seniors in the greater metro area.
