As Avenue Scholars continues to significantly impact the lives of teens and young adults facing adversity, the success stories of our Scholars demonstrate the program's effectiveness. One such story is that of Edgar, a graduate of Ralston High School and a dedicated student.

Edgar, a high-achieving student at Metropolitan Community College, is studying Construction and Building Science in construction management. He demonstrates dedication to his career at Enterprise Precast Concrete, which manufactures and supplies high-quality architectural precast components, including panels and custom fabrications. Over nearly three years, Edgar's responsibilities have expanded significantly. As a new hire, Edgar began working with foam used on insulated panels, then he progressed to bricklaying, outside washing, moving bricks, and panel preparation. His career advanced further as he joined the load crew, where he was responsible for strapping, setting up, and loading heavy precast panels onto trailers.

Edgar's most recent role involves heavy machine operation, requiring hours of training to develop expertise. He is one of three operators at Enterprise Precast Concrete who is trained to use the specialized Mi-Jack Travelift Rubber Tired Gantry (RTG) Crane for placing and storing panels efficiently.

The precast concrete panels Edgar handles can be up to about 40 feet wide by 12 feet high. A single panel can weigh several tons. The responsibility of safely maneuvering these expensive and heavy components underscores the confidence Edgar has earned from his supervisors.

Avenue Scholars' commitment extends beyond initial employment with Career Services Coaches, like Anthony Tate (pictured above), regularly checking in with the Scholar and their employer. This continuous support has been important in Edgar's
